Lighting affects our environment and everything we experience in many ways. Light enables vision and times the rhythms of human alertness. Finland needs experts in the field of lighting for various tasks, both for companies and the public sector, and new knowledge will help the whole society. In order to encourage students to illuminate the future and see the present more closely, the Illuminating Engineering Society of Finland will award a prize of EUR 2 000 for the most enlightening thesis. The competition is open to all theses approved in Finland from 1.1.2021 to 31.12.2022, which cover light, lighting, lighting control, light sources or luminaires from a scientific, artistic or practical point of view.

Theses participating in the competition, such as master's theses, diploma theses, polytechnic theses and dissertations with possible appendices, must be announced by 31 December 2022 via the online link
